


Accessing Citrix Desktop via the Citrix Receiver

1. Go to <https://www.citrix.com/products/receiver.html>. Then click **Download for Windows**. **Note: please download the receiver for the operating system on your computer.**


3. Double click the CitrixWorkspaceapp.exe to install the citrix receiver.


4. Click Start


5. Select I accept the license agreement. Click Install. Citrix Workspace should start installing




6. Click Add Account.




7. You will have to reboot your computer at this point





12. Select **Student Windows 10 Edu Desktop** to open it.


